Mavericks baseball team sweeps

FORT PIERCE, FLA. — The Minnesota State University baseball team swept a nonconference doubleheader from Wisconsin-Parkside Tuesday during spring games in Florida.

MSU won 6-4 and 3-2.

In the opener, Nick Gonzalez went 2 for 3 and drove in a run. Teammate Adam Sudbeck homered and drove in two runs and Pat Ottum also had two RBIs.

Tyler Sander got the win with relief help from Nick Fellman. Sander allowed four runs on six hits walked four and struck out six. Fellman struck out the final batter to get the save.

In Game 2, MSU managed just four hits but outscored Parkside 3-2.

Kyle Hoover led the MSU attack with a two-run double down the left-field line in the third inning.

Jake Reuvers got the win, allowing two runs on two hits, fanning five and walking two.

Fellman pitched the last two scoreless innings for his sixth save.

MSU is back in action at 3 p.m. today with a doubleheader against Clarion University.
