

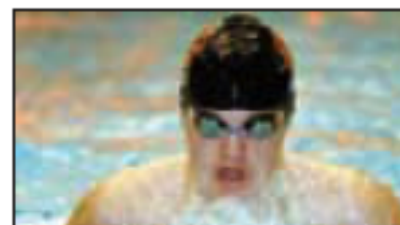

## Minnesota State

The Mavericks' men's and women's teams continue non-conference action against Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference teams this weekend, with the men hosting Minnesota-Crookston on Saturday and the women playing at Minnesota-Crookston on Saturday and at Bemidji State on Sunday.

The men (6-3) are on a two-game winning streak following Thursday's 72-57 victory over Southwest Minnesota State at Bresnan Arena, and junior guard Luke Anderson's streak of games with at least 20 points is now at nine games. Going back to last season, Anderson has scored 20 or more points in 11 of his last 12 games. Since gaining a spot in the starting lineup four games

ago, senior forward Rueben Trotter is averaging 11 points and 6.8 rebounds, and he's scored 10 or more points in the last three games. The Mavericks have three double-doubles, one each by Anderson, Chris Whitfield and Corey Easley.

The women (5-3) had a two-game winning streak ended by Concordia-St. Paul on Wednesday. Senior center Arin Andrews was honored by the North Central Conference as one of three players of the week. She's averaging 15.0 points and 7.5 rebounds, while shooting 62.0 percent from the field. Heather Peterson is averaging 9.9 points and 5.1 rebounds. The Mavericks are outrebounding opponents by more than six per game.
