MSU's Kehler records second straight shutout

ST. CLOUD — Minnesota State sophomore goaltender Brit Kehler was rock steady for a second straight game Saturday, stopping 26 St. Cloud State shots en route to a 2-0 women's hockey win. Kehler stopped all 56 shots she faced in the weekend sweep.

The Mavericks jumped to an early lead at 18:30 when sophomore Kristina Bunker scored a power-play goal off a missed shot by junior Autumn Conway. Conway and senior Jen Jonsson were both credit-

ed with assists.

In the second period, sophomore Noelle Needham made good on a rebound from an errant Bunker shot. Conway was given her second assist of the night.

The win pushes the Mavs to 9-4-1 overall and 6-3-1 in conference play. In just 12 games, the team has matched last season's win total.

The Mavericks have next weekend off before a road series at Minnesota-Duluth Dec. 2-3.
