Mavericks women's hockey squad sweeps series

MANKATO — Noelle Needham scored twice in the second period, sparking Minnesota State to a 5-1 victory over Wayne State in nonconference women's hockey Saturday at All Seasons Arena.

Brittany Mackley scored the only goal of the first period, putting the Mavericks on top 1-0 at 14:23 with assists from Alycia Wilson and Jodi Helminen.

Needham's first goal came at 10:15 of the second period with an assist from Amanda Stohr, then Felicia Nelson added a short-handed goal just 35 seconds later with an assist from Maggie Fisher. Needham's second goal completed the three-minute blitz, with an assist from Autumn Conway,

that made it 4-0.

Kristina Bunker scored the only goal of the third period, with an assist from Conway, as the Mavericks completed the weekend sweep.

Britni Kehler made 31 saves for the Mavericks (7-4-1), who had 29 shots on goal.

Wrestling

Jeff Pfaffinger, John Koons and Tim Kraemer each finished second in the respective weight classes Saturday at the Wisconsin-Stevens Point Open.

Pfaffinger placed second at 133 pounds, losing to Wisconsin's Zach Tanelli. At 184 pounds, Koons placed second to Northern Illinois' Duke Burk. Kraemer was runner-up

to Wisconsin's Kyle Massey at 275.

Ben Janike (197) and Brandon Girtz (157) each placed third, and Mathias Bitz took fourth at 157.

Women's bowling

After going 2-1 on the first day of the Maverick Duals Friday, MSU went 1-4 on day two. Minnesota State opened the day with a 989-922 loss to Central Missouri State with Michelle Hopper leading the way with a 230.

The Mavericks lone win came over Elmhurst College 925-900 as Cathleen Kowalski rolled a 193. MSU finished the day with a 1,040-855 loss to Nebraska and a 961-868 loss to Arkansas State.
