VERMILLION, S.D. — The Minnesota State University volleyball team swept South Dakota Friday, downing the Coyotes 30-22, 30-25, 30-19 in a North Central Conference match in the DakotaDome.

Megan Stroud belted 13 kills for the Mavericks. Mandy Reuter added 12 kills and Belle Plaine native Cassie Wolpern smacked 10.

Stef Sandstrom led MSU with 41 set assists and 12 digs. Reuter had 11 digs. Cathy Turner finished with three blocks.

Gabi Jarchow led USD with eight kills. Casey Beardsley and Gina Baldwin both had eight assists. Amber Kobus led the Coyotes with 13 digs and Jamie Vander Kooi added 10.

The Mavericks (13-6, 3-2 in NCC) play a 6 p.m. match at

Nebraska-Omaha today. The Coyotes (4-5, 0-5) also play today when they host North Dakota at 8 p.m.
